

The Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act (40CFR355) requires that LEPC's be notified immediately in the event of an accidental release of a reportable chemical if the amount released exceeds the threshold reporting quantity and does not meet any of the exemptions in 40CFR355.31.

A written follow-up report is required. To promote uniformity, we are requesting that your emergency release initial notification and follow-up report use the following format. Provide as much information as known at the time of the initial report.
